Policy statement

Policy measures

We will

- Meet all relevant environmental legislation and regulations

- Use water carefully and efficiently
- Avoid pollutants entering the drainage system
- Avoid the production of material waste including unnecessary packaging
- Encourage re-use, repair and recycling of materials
- Dispose of waste in a safe and responsible way
- Buy products and services which produced in an environmentally manner wherever possible
- Use locally made products and services where possible
- Use electronic communication where possible to reduce the use of paper
- Aim to reduce the carbon footprint of the Village Hall building in any refurbishment and improvement work we undertake
- Encourage users of the Village Hall to travel on foot or bicycle, and to share transport where possible
- Facilitate the provision of social activities within the Parish to reduce the need to travel
